

2006 Burger King Scholars Program – USA Information, Guidelines and Application

Scholarship Awards

Awards are \$1,000 each and may be used for educational expenses during the first year of college or postsecondary vocational/technical school. In 2006, approximately 1,500 scholarships will be awarded throughout the United States, Canada and Puerto Rico.

Burger King Scholars is a program of the Burger King/McLamore Foundation (the "Foundation"), a non-profit corporation. The Foundation is dedicated to "Building Brighter Futures Through Education in Our Communities".

Administrative support for the Burger King Scholars Program is provided by Scholarship America, a national nonprofit educational support and student aid service organization.

Awards are given without regard to race, color, creed, religion, gender, disability or national origin.

Eligibility Criteria

Students may apply from public, private, vocational, technical, parochial and alternative high schools throughout the United States, Canada and Puerto Rico. Applicants must be high school seniors who:

- Maintain a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or higher on a 4.0 scale or the equivalent.
- Work part-time an average of 15 hours per week, 40 weeks per year (unless individual circumstances prevents the student's involvement).
- Demonstrate participation in community service and/or co-curricular activities.
- Demonstrate financial need.
- Receive written nominination and signature from a school official **and** an employer recommendation (neither of whom is related to the student).
- Plan to enroll in an accredited two- or four-year college, university, or vocational/technical school by Fall 2006.

Please note that students **DO NOT** have to be employed at a BURGER KING[®] restaurant to be eligible for a scholarship. However, BURGER KING employees **may** be eligible.

Application Process

All applicants must be nominated for a Burger King Scholars award by their school's scholarship coordinator, principal, school counselor, or other such school official. In addition, applicants must also receive the recommendation of their employer. Applicants cannot be related to those recommending them. **Only one student may be nominated by each school to apply for the scholarship.** Upon receiving the school's nomination, the student may enter the scholarship competition by submitting a completed application to the program.

Students must complete the entire <u>2006 application</u>. The student, the nominating school official, the employer and a parent/guardian must sign the application. It should be mailed with a current complete high school transcript of grades to Scholarship America, postmarked no later than **December 15, 2005**.

Applicants are responsible for completing all necessary information, getting required signatures, and submitting all required information on or before the deadline. Students chosen to receive awards may have their information and photographs publicized as part of Burger King Scholars promotions or publicity activities.

Recipient Selection

Recipients are selected on the basis of academic achievement, work experience, co-curricular and/or community involvement, financial need, and recommendations by their school and employer.

Scholarships will be awarded based on selection procedures set forth by Scholarship America and the Foundation.

Only students selected as recipients will receive written notification from Scholarship America in late April 2006.

Awards are limited; not every nominee will receive an award.

Payment of Awards

Scholarship payments are made in one installment of \$1,000 on August 1, 2006. Checks are mailed to each recipient's home address and are made payable to the school on behalf of the student.

Obligations

Burger King Scholars recipients must be enrolled in their educational programs no later than the 2006 Fall term. Recipients must respond to their award letter from Scholarship America in a timely manner and provide requested information and photographs for publicity purposes.

Although there are no further obligations to the Foundation, recipients are encouraged to express gratitude to individual BURGER KING[®] restaurant owners who raised the funds and "sponsored" their scholarship. If possible, recipients are also encouraged to invite their "sponsors" to an appropriate school awards ceremony or to attend an event in their honor by the BURGER KING[®] restaurant owner.

Revision Policy

The general conditions and procedures under which scholarships are made are subject to periodic review by Scholarship America and the Foundation, including termination of the program.
